Contracting

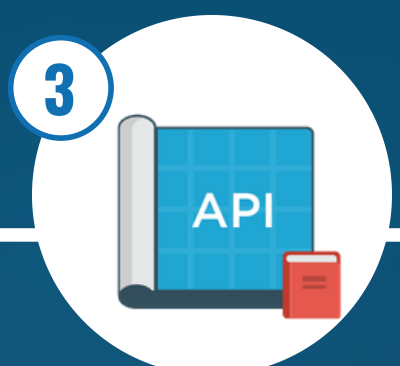
Once you select a supplier, provide them your business details, sign the commercial contract and pay the deposit to get started



1

Supplier Selection

Choose a supplier that's best for you based on your region, supplier rates, products, availability, requirements etc.



3

API Documentation

Once the contract is signed, the supplier will provide the API document along with test access and test feeds



4

Feasibility Study

The technology vendor will study the API Document and check if they need to build a new adapter for it or integrate the API using an existing adapter



6

Integration

After the certification, the supplier will provide credentials to access live feeds that will be integrated into the booking engine



5

Certification

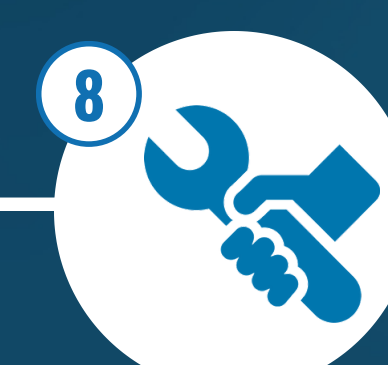
Once the adapter is ready, it will need to be tested & certified by the supplier to ensure it complies with their standards



7

Go Live

Once the integration is complete, your clients will start seeing real-time fares and availability and will be able to book the same



8

Maintenance & Upgrades

Your technology vendor will continue providing services such as connector maintenance, version upgrades and metadata updates
